Youth Core Team is:

- A Church leadership program that allows high school students to use their gifts and talents to serve our students in Clare's Kids, EDGE, Life Teen and/or Confirmation programs.
- An opportunity to develop skills like team communication, planning, public speaking, time management, facilitating discussion groups, hospitality, using the Bible, evangelization, and more...
- A ministry all about evangelization. This team will give students the opportunity to live their faith boldly at church, in school, and at home.
- For any High School student who has already been Confirmed in their faith. (If not confirmed yet, you must be at least a junior in high school to apply.)
- Fun, exciting, entertaining, and a great way to make new friends!
- Hard work that demands time, commitment, and sacrifice.
- Good for service hours and college/job references as long as there is regular attendance to all mandatory meetings.

Youth Core Team is not:

- For extroverts only.
- A clique or club.
- A chance to prove you are better than others.

Expectations

Being part of the Youth Core Team is an important job that requires FAITH, HUMILITY, and LEADERSHIP. We take it very seriously, so the following expectations are to help you do the best job possible! This is what is expected of EVERY Youth Core Team member:

- Every participant should attend Mass regularly (at least every Sunday).
- Participants are required to attend ALL meetings and training on time and complete all their work by assigned deadlines.
 - Completing your work means that your work has been reviewed and approved by church staff or other appointed adults.
- All participants are expected to keep up good communication. Frequently check their email and other means of communication and *always respond back*.
- Behave as a servant leader at all times.
- Participants are expected to follow the Code of Conduct and Covenant.
- Participants must continue to be active in Life Teen.
- All participants will be required to undergo leadership formation before being allowed to serve in the 2026-2027 school year.
- Every participant must keep a calendar, meeting notes, and a binder for all assigned tasks.
- Youth Core Team must always keep an inclusive and welcoming spirit towards others. They are to show kindness and respect to all around them.
- Youth Core Team should always strive to keep a positive and constructive attitude with themselves and others.
- Youth Core Team should be actively pursuing holiness in their own lives and seeking to make a positive influence on others around them.

Commitment: Once a month, Sunday, 12:00-2:00pm.

- Life Teen**
Responsibilities include meeting once a month to evaluate and plan Life Nights and Life Teen events with a growth mindset. This team will consider ways to increase the number of people we reach, and at the same time strengthen the community that is present.

Other Responsibilities for Youth Core Team might include:

- Leadership roles at First Communion and Confirmation Mass
- Involvement in evangelization and community events for the Parish

Peer Ministry Code of Conduct

1. You are called to be Ambassadors for Christ to your friends and family. For this reason, you must avoid illegal and un-Christian activities throughout your daily life—at church, at school, at home, on social media, and with friends. This includes stealing, violence, reckless driving, drinking, smoking, bullying and drug use.
2. You should always respect adults in authority, this includes: parents, teachers, priests, parish staff, core members, etc...
3. You must refrain from inappropriate physical contact. You must also refrain from sexual harassment (verbal or physical), inappropriate jokes, inappropriate displays of affection, cursing, foul language, and using God's name in vain and any other comments not befitting for a representative of the Church.
4. You must be welcoming and inclusive of all students regardless of age, race, school, and opinions which they hold.
5. You must stay focused and devoted to the tasks at hand and those assigned to you.
6. Instagram, Snapchat, TikTok or any public website/social media platform must never be used to share negative opinions of Saint Clare of Assisi, the Catholic Church, or any individuals connected to Youth Ministry.
