### Effects of Sin


Damages or kills life of grace in soul Wounds the Body of Christ, the Church

### Required Acts of the Penitent

#### Contrition

- Perfect
- Imperfect

Confession of all grave sins

Satisfaction



Form

"May...God...forgive you both in this life and in the next ..."



#### **Effects**

Reconciliation with God and restoration of grace

Reconciliation with the Church

Remission of eternal and (at least in part) temporal punishment

Consolation

Strength for Christian battle

Examine conscience
Be sorry for sins
Resolve to avoid sin
In the confessional:

- Open with time since last confession
- Confess sins
- Receive penance
- Pray Act of Contrition
- Receive absolutionDo penance
