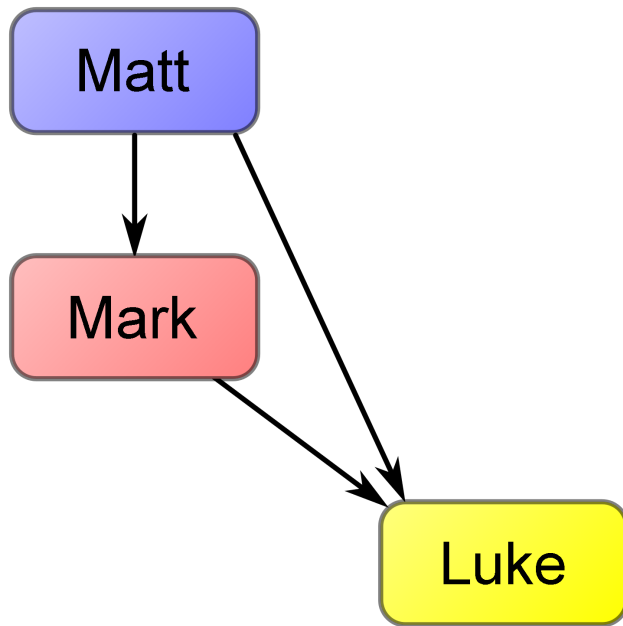

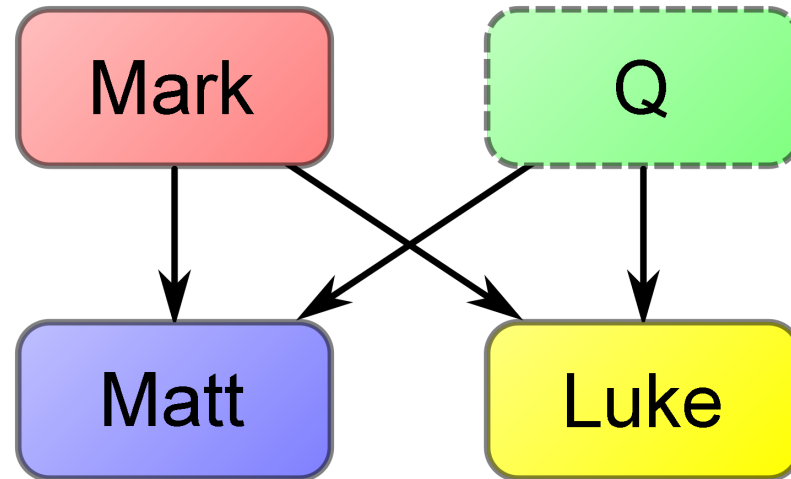
The Synoptic Problem

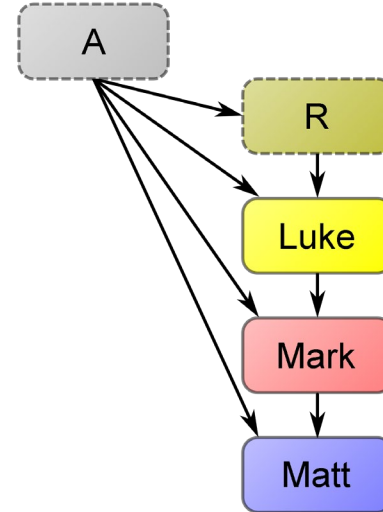
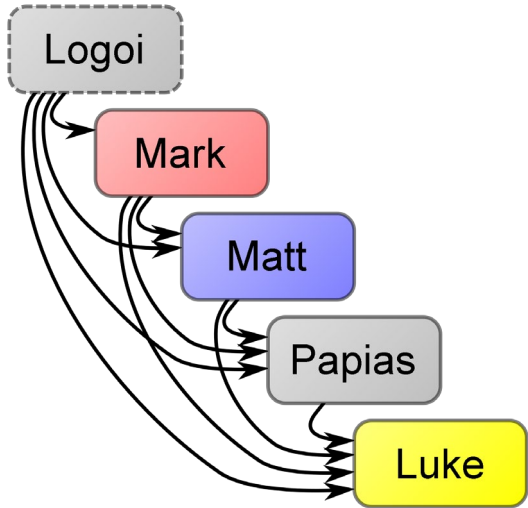
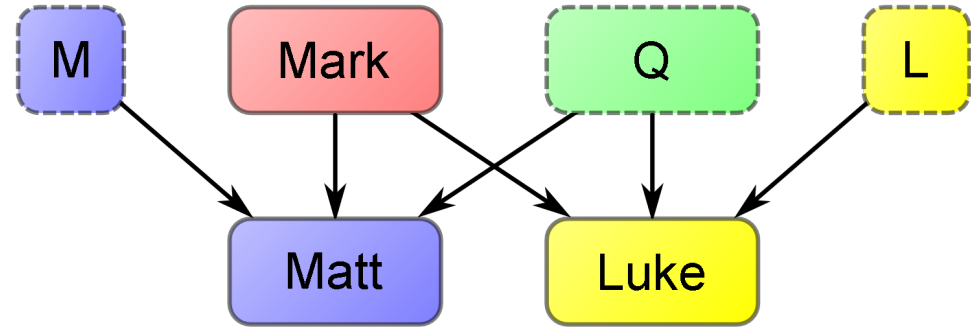
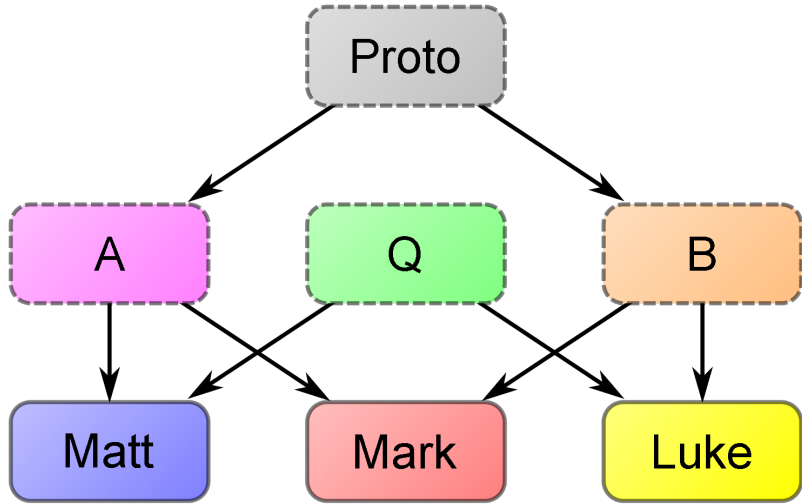
St. Augustine (5th cent.)

- High Christology

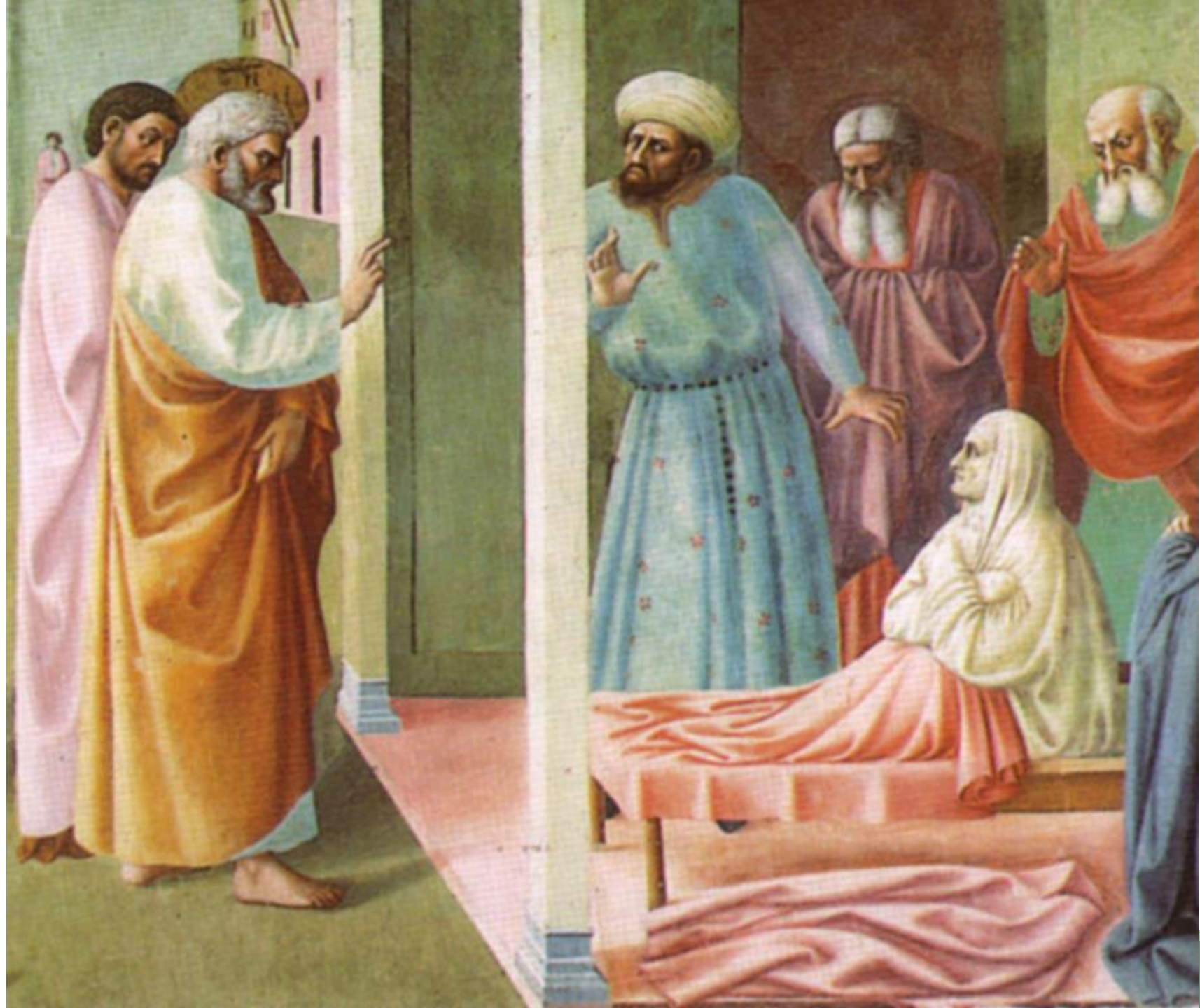


Baptism of Jesus
